Golf Course Expectations:

All Country Club of Barre local rules are in effect including suggested dress code and player conduct. A minimum of 72 players is required for the golf course to consider an 18-hole shotgun start. Events with fewer players may be considered on a case by case basis and must be approved by the CCB Board of Directors. An event with fewer than 72 players may be required to have a modified shotgun start or a "tee time" start in order for the course to remain open for play. The event sponsor must let the Country Club of Barre know the confirmed number of guests one week prior to starting the event. Failure to do so may result in additional fees being assessed due to costs incurred by the club (i.e. ordering extra carts that are not used, etc).

Event Fees:

CCB reserves the right to collect a non-refundable deposit of \$250 to secure the date of your tournament.

The Country Club of Barre offers a competitive golf event pricing structure based on a number of factors including: number of players, day of week, and peak vs. non-peak season. Please inquire with the PGA Professional or CCB Board of Directors to learn more about these factors and how they impact the cost for your tournament.

*The contractual cost per player is largely determined based on the number of players projected for the event. If there is a significant discrepancy between the projected number of players and actual number of players, the Country Club of Barre reserves the right to charge a minimum event fee equivalent to the projected number of players listed in this contract times the agreed upon per-person cost.

For example, if the event cost per player is based on a 72 person field and the field is only 60 players, the event may be charged for 72 players at the contractual cost per player. If more than 72 players play, the cost will be assessed per player at the contractual price.

Payment is due in full on the day of the event unless other arrangements are made in advance. We understand that many of the events hosted at the Country Club of Barre are fundraisers that raise most of their money on the day of their event. In keeping with golf's long standing honor system, CCB does not require a deposit, although advance installment payments may be made if desired.

Golf Cart Agreement:

Golf carts are only to be driven in acceptable areas. All attendees are expected to abide by any posted signage and club rules. Damages to the golf course, cart fleet, or other property due to misconduct by participants in the event will be charged to the event host. Accountability of the individual at fault for these expenses will be the responsibility of the event host, not the Country Club of Barre.

Prizes and gifts:

When looking for welcome gifts or prizes, please remember to shop local. The Pro Shop at CCB is offers a wide assortment of gifts and prizes to fit all of your golfing needs. If you're looking for some custom swag, you can even contact the Pro Shop in advance to order golf balls and shirts embossed with your event logo! From tees and golf balls to equipment and apparel, all leading golf brands are available at the CCB Pro Shop at competitive prices. If you can't find what you're looking for, we are happy to order it.

Food and Beverage:

Food and beverage needs, including a beverage cart, must be arranged through Fairways and Greens. Fairways and Greens offers various menu options including bag lunches, hot food at the turn, and sit down lunch/dinner options. Example menus are available upon request. **No outside food or beverages, including alcohol, are permitted.**

Cancellation Policy:

Cancellation of the event will only be considered if the Country Club of Barre closes the course to all play due to inclement weather or other unavoidable circumstances. This decision will be made solely by the Country Club of Barre and will be communicated to the event contact as quickly as possible. The event will be rescheduled based on availability but is not guaranteed.
